



Neck Warmer

Skills Required - Garter stitch

Measurements: Circumference is approximately 18 inches without being stretched and the depth is approximately 10 inches.

Gauge: 12 sts and 16 rows = 4 inches

Materials: Any 5-Bulky yarn will work, (i.e. 1 skein of Bernat Roving) in whatever color you like.

Needles: US 10.5 (6.5 mm)

Tapestry Needle

Pattern Notes:

You may find it easier to seam the neck warmer with a different yarn. Roving yarn doesn't seam up very well and tends to come apart as you're seaming.

That's because it's not a twisted yarn so it tends to break easily. When the yarn is knitted it's strong but when you keep pulling it through to seam with it the friction causes it to break.

Try a worsted weight yarn that closely matches the yarn you used. Of course if you want to try using the roving yarn do give it a try.

Cast on 30 stitches.

Work garter stitch for approximately 106 rows (53 ridges of garter stitch). Bind off loosely

Finish: Sew up seam and enjoy.

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
