CITIZENSHIP FUND

- Provides for projects of the Provincial Citizenship Department
- *IODE Ontario Provincial Police Community Relations Award* is given annually at the time of the Provincial Annual Meeting. The recipient receives \$500 to be used for a community service program of their choice.

PEACEKEEPER PARK

- This is a new project established in 2010 for a new cabin to be built in Peacekeeper Park over a period of five years.
- Peacekeeper Park, located within the Kettle Creek Conservation Area near Aylmer, Ontario, provides wilderness training for youth and cadets, including the physically challenged, has a memorial walk commemorating all of the Canadian Peacekeeping Missions and hosts Broken Wing, a support service for returning soldiers suffering from PTSD.

COMMUNICATIONS FUND

- Established to promote IODE through radio, TV, internet and printed media
- Prints promotional materials
- Development and maintenance of the Provincial web site

LUCY MORRISON MEMORIAL FUND FOR EDUCATION

- This is the Provincial Education Fund named for a Past Provincial President.
- Bursaries ranging in value from \$500 - \$1,000 are awarded to worthy students who need financial assistance to continue their post secondary education. Applications from Universities and Colleges in Ontario arrive continuously. The need is great. Your contributions are always most welcome.
- Special Annual Awards of \$1,000 each are given to students in the fields of Art & Design and Ballet. An additional \$2,000 Annual Award is alternately given to students in the fields of Music Performance or Applied Ecology.

NORTHERN ONTARIO EDUCATION FUND

- Established in 2005 to assist Northern Ontario schools in emergency situations (fire, flood, etc.) or to help a class or school establish a new educational program.
- Requests for assistance must come from the teachers with the written approval of the Principal.
- Your contributions will provide greatly needed assistance to schools in very remote locations.

- In late November toy shipments are sent to all locations receiving assistance from Services. This special shipment is eagerly awaited and ensures that children receive at least one toy for Christmas.

SERVICES SHIPPING FUND

- This fund was established in 2007 so that we could continue sending shipments to the many locations that depend on our support.
- All money in this fund goes directly to pay for shipping charges.

CONCERN FOR CHILDREN FUND - "IT'S ALL ABOUT GENES"

- Established in 1973, this fund supports projects in the field of genetic medicine.
- The Turner Syndrome Society project was fully achieved with a total of \$10,000 being presented over the two year initiative. Support was greatly appreciated.

- Funds are used to help defray some of the travelling expenses of Provincial Officers when visiting chapters in response to your invitations.
