



**IODE Ontario**  
**Child's Keyhole Neck Warmer Pattern**

**You will need: 2 Balls of yarn, 5 or 6 mm. Needles**

**Cast on 24 stitches.**

**Work in garter stitch (k1, p1) for 6 inches ending with wrong side of facing**

**Next row: \* K1, slip next stitch onto spare needle.\* Repeat from \* to \* to end of row.**

**12 stitches and place remaining 12 stitches on holder.**

**Work in rib on the 12 stitches for 3 inches, ending with right side of facing. Cut yarn and place these stitches on second stitch holder. Slip stitches from first holder back to needles and join yarn. Knit for 4 inches, same as for first slit making sure that the garter stitch ridges match up evenly on both sides of keyhole. (You have created the keyhole)**

**Bring all the stitches together.**

**Next row: Knit across 12 stitches on needle. Slip the 12 stitches from holder onto left needle (make sure the stitches aren't twisted) and continue knitting across row. Work in garter stitch until work measures 28 inches from the beginning, ending with right side facing.**

**Cast off.**
