

**2020-2021 National Councillors**  
**Elected as of April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

**Article VIII, Section 8.06 Councillors – National**

Each province or territory shall be entitled to elect one National Chapter Councillor for the first twenty (20) primary chapters in good standing within its jurisdiction and an additional councillor for every twenty (20) chapters. In addition, each provincial chapter shall be entitled at its annual meeting to elect three (3) additional National Chapter Councillors.

As per letter received from IODE Canada (January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019) permission has been granted by the Board of Directors to increase the number of National councillors to be elected in Ontario from 6 National Councillors to 9 National Councillors.

**Provincial By-law #16**

That a nominee for Provincial and/or National Councillor shall stand for election in the designated area in which active membership is held, with the exception of a nominee from a chapter already under Municipal jurisdiction. Such nominees shall stand for election in the area in which that Municipal Chapter is located.
